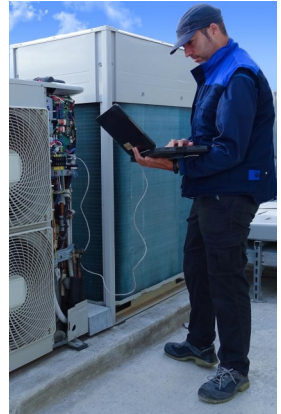
HVAC & R

The HVAC & R program is an individual program that prepares students to work in a variety of jobs in the field of air conditioning and refrigeration. Students are prepared to troubleshoot, repair, and maintain residential and commercial refrigeration; air conditioning; heat pumps; humidifiers; and electrical and gas heating. Students also learn the fundamentals of electricity, electric motors, and controls. Graduates of the program will be able to install and braze refrigeration tubing, diagnose electrical problems; install duct systems; repair light commercial equipment; recover air conditioning & refrigeration refrigerants; locate & repair leaks.

- Please fill out your Welcome Packets and bring them back ASAP so you will be eligible to go on trips.
- See your Talent Search Adviser to get permission slips for our college visits this semester.
- **Our Christmas trip will be Saturday, December 14th, 2024.**
- Juniors and Seniors: we have ACT vouchers so you can take the ACT for FREE!! We recommend you all register for an ACT with us to increase your chances of getting a better ACT score (**which will make you more eligible for more scholarship money!!** The higher your ACT score, the more money you will receive in merit based scholarships from schools).
- Juniors must take the ACT before April 1st to be eligible for our Spring/Summer trip.
- Seniors must apply to 2 colleges and (TN students only) have their TN Promise complete to go on the Christmas trip. Make sure to send your Talent Search Adviser proof of your college applications, and complete your TN Promise with the Ayers Foundation so you may be eligible for the trip.

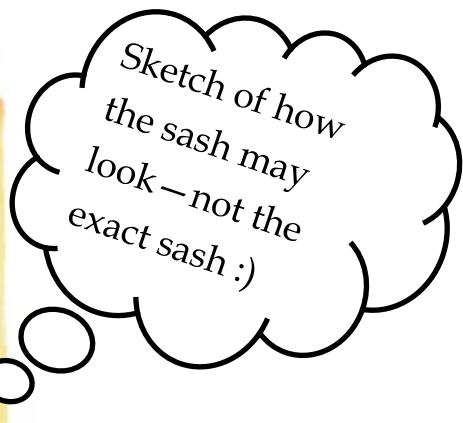
- ♥ September 14th, 2024

Seniors

This year Seniors will receive a graduation sash by meeting the following requirements:

1. Apply for a minimum of 2 colleges/trade schools by December 1st
2. Apply to Tennessee Promise by November 1st (TN Seniors ONLY)
3. Complete your FAFSA by March 1st
4. Attend at least 1 Talent Search College Visit your senior year OR have a minimum of 8 sign ins with your Talent Search Adviser your senior year
